October is Sudden Cardiac Arrest Awareness Month

What is Sudden Cardiac Arrest

Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is a life-threatening emergency that occurs when the heart suddenly stops beating. It strikes people of all ages who may seem to be healthy, even children and teens.

Today only one in 10 survives Sudden Cardiac Arrest. But with immediate CPR and use of an AED, five in 10 victims could survive. It's a fact that CPR and AEDs can save lives. But there is a critical need to raise awareness about SCA, educate people about the importance of taking immediate action, and empower communities to provide CPR training and widespread access to AEDs.

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
